

Free Crochet Patterns

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***Free Tree Top Angel
Crochet Pattern***

Treetop Angel

Materials: Size 10 Crochet Cotton 210 yds

Crochet Hook Size 6 or 1.80 mm

Starch, Stuffing, Glue

Approximate Finished Size: 9" Tall

Head:

Rnd 1: (right side): Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do not join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around: 12 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 18 sc.

Rnd 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 24 sc.

Rnd 5: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 30 sc.

Rnd 6: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 36 sc.

Rnd 7: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc) around: 42 sc.

Rnd 8: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc) around: 48 sc.

Rnd 9-12: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 13: (Decrease (below), sc in next 6 sc) around. 42 sc.

Rnd 14: (Decrease, sc in next 5 sc) around: 36 sc.

Rnd 15: (Decrease, sc in next 4 sc) around: 30 sc.

Rnd 16: (Decrease, sc in next 3 sc) around: 24 sc.

Rnd 17: (Decrease, sc in next 2 sc) around: 18 sc.

Rnd 18: (Decrease, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc.

Rnd 19: Decrease around, slip st in next sc; do not finish off: 6 sc.

Dress:

Rnd 1: (right side): Ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), 2 dc in same st, 3 dc in next sc and in each sc around; join with sl st to first dc: 18 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same st and in next dc, * 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * around; join with sl st to first dc: 27 dc.

Rnd 3 and 4: Ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in next dc and in each dc around; join with slip st to first dc: 108 dc.

Rnd 5 and 6: Ch 3, dc in next dc and in each dc around; join with sl st to first dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in each of next 4 dc, skip next 42 dc (armhole), 2 dc in each of next 12 dc, skip next 42 dc (armhole), 2 dc in last 7 dc; join with slip st to first dc: 48 dc.

Rnd 8: Ch 4 (counts as first dc plus ch 1, now and throughout), dc in same st and in next dc, * work V-st (below) in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * around; join with slip st to first dc: 24 V-sts.

Rnd 9: Sl st in first ch-1 sp, ch 4, dc in same sp, skip next dc, dc in next dc, * work V-st in next V-st (ch-1 sp), skip next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * around; join with sl st to first dc.

Rnd 10: Sl st in first ch-1 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in same sp, work shell in next V-st and in each V-st around; join with sl st to first dc.

Rnds 11 to 23: Sl st in next dc and in first ch-1 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in same sp, work shell in nex shell (ch-1 sp) and in each shell around; join with sl st to first dc.

Rnd 24: Sl st in next dc and in first ch-1 sp, ch 1, sc in same sp, 7 dc in sp before next shell, * sc in next shell, 7 dc in sp before next shell; repeat from * around; join with sl st to first sc, finish off.

Armhole Edging:

With right side facing working in unworked dc of armhole, join thread with sl st in first dc; ch 1, sc in same st, * skip nex dc, 5 dc in next dc, work Picot, 5 dc in ext dc, skip next dc, sc in next dc; repeat fcrom * around to last dc, skip last dc; join with sl st to first sc, finish off.

Repeat for second armhole.

Halo:

Rnd 1 (right side): Ch 2, 6 sc in second ch from hook; do not join, place marker.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around: 12 sc.

Rnd 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around, sl st in next sc, remove marker: 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same st, (ch 5, skip next sc, sc in next sc) around to last sc, skip last sc, ch 2, dc in first sc to form last ch-5 sp: 9 ch-5 sps.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 7, (sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 7) around; join with sl st to first sc, finish off.

Wings:

First Side: Ch 12 loosely.

Row 1: (right side): Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across: 11 sc.

Row 2 and 3: Ch 3, turn: dc in first st, * dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; repeat from * across: 26 sts.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn; sc in next dc, * ch 3, skip next dc, sc in next dc; repeat from * across: 13 ch-3 sps.

Rows 5 and 6: Ch 3, turn; sc in first ch-3 sp, * ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp; repeat from * across.

Row 7: Ch 3, turn; 2 dc in first sc, sc in next ch-3 sp, * 3 dc in next sc, sc in next ch-3 sp; repeat from * across: 13 sc.

Row 8: (Increase row): Ch 3, turn; skip first dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, * skip next 3 sts, sc in next dc, ch 3; repeat from * across to last st, sc in last st: 14 ch-3 sts.

Row 9: (Increase row): Ch 3, turn; sc in first ch-3 sp, * ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp; repeat from * across to last ch-3 sp, (ch, sc) twice in last ch-3 sp: 15 ch-3 sps.

Row 10: Ch 3, turn; sc in first ch-3 sp, * ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp; repeat from * across.

Rows 11 to 14: Repeat rows 7 to 10: 17 ch-3 sps.

Row 15: Ch 1, turn; sc in first ch-3 sp, * 7 dc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next ch-3 sp; repeat from * across, finish off.

Second Side:

Row 1: With right side facing and working in free loops of beginning ch, join thread with slip st in first ch; ch 1, sc in same st and in next 10 chs: 11 sc.

Rows 2-15: Work same as first side.

Starch. Using photo as a guide for placement, glue halo and wings in place.

Decrease: Pull up a loop in next 2 sc, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook (counts as one sc)

V-St: (Dc, ch 1, dc) in st or sp indicated.

Shell: (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in sp indicated.

Picot: Ch 3, sl st in top of dc just made.
